GENERAL COMPLAINT

IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Investigator Miguel Lopez #2283 who, after being by me duly sworn on oath deposes and says that he has good reason to believe and does believe and charge that heretofore, and before the making and filing of this complaint on or about the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2021, in the county of Hidalgo, State of Texas Daniel Flores (DOB: 11/19/77) hereinafter called Defendant, did then and there, commit the offense of:

OFFENSE: CAPITAL MURDER

OFFENSE: 19.03(a)(8) / 09990029 / Felony X

CASE # 21-06600

On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, at 5:07 PM, Hidalgo County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area north of 5 Mile Line on La Homa Road, east on Valencia Street to a gray frame residence on the south side of the roadway (2403 Valencia Street), rural Mission, Hidalgo County, Texas, in regards to a Capital Murder.

Sheriff's Deputies arrived to the location and located a 6 year old female child who was found deceased from a gunshot wound. Deputies were advised by people at the residence that there was a drive by shooting at the residence which caused the death of the child.

Sheriff's Investigators were able to identify a suspect, Daniel Flores, through surveillance video, and were able to locate him and transport him to the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office where he was interviewed and confessed to knowingly and intentionally taking part of the drive by shooting, which caused the death of a child under 10 years of age.

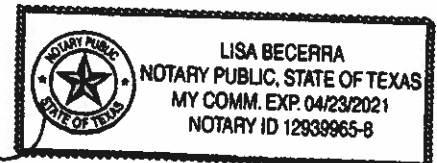
